3. Email a full-size, color team photo (preferably in team uniform holding your District Champions banner) to vad6da@cox.net. List the players and coaches as they appear in the photo for identification, e.g., Front Row: Sara Smith, Jillian Hewitt, etc.
4. Email the team roster, including players' first and last names (not necessarily their legal name, but the name they go by) and jersey number to vad6da@cox.net to be added to the program. Please ensure you provide the correct spelling and jersey number for the team manager, coaches, and all players. Thank you.
5. Contact one of the local hotels to reserve rooms for your team (see page 7 for a list of nearby lodging options. Hampton Roads has many waterways and is home to the Navy's Atlantic Fleet. Traffic jams spring up quickly and can take hours to navigate. We recommend selecting lodgings close to the tournament location and have identified recommended hotels later in this packet to help avoid high traffic bottlenecks.
6. Please ensure you bring the following: **District/State Tournament Official Affidavit**, with the **Tournament Player Verification Forms**, correct amount, and type of **proofs of residency, waivers, medical releases, and Tournament Pitching record**, or a letter from Southeastern Region with permission to advance without tournament play. You must provide any Charter Committee waivers that the team has received from Little League Baseball and Softball® or Southeastern Region. **All uniforms must have a Little League patch correctly affixed to the jersey.**
7. Please make sure all team equipment is legal and in good repair. Bats **must not** have any fractures, dents, or flat spots and must be a Little League authorized bat that meets all rules in accordance with <https://www.littleleague.org/playing-rules/bat-rules/#softball>. **All unauthorized or damaged equipment will be removed and held by District 6 staff until the team departs the tournament.**

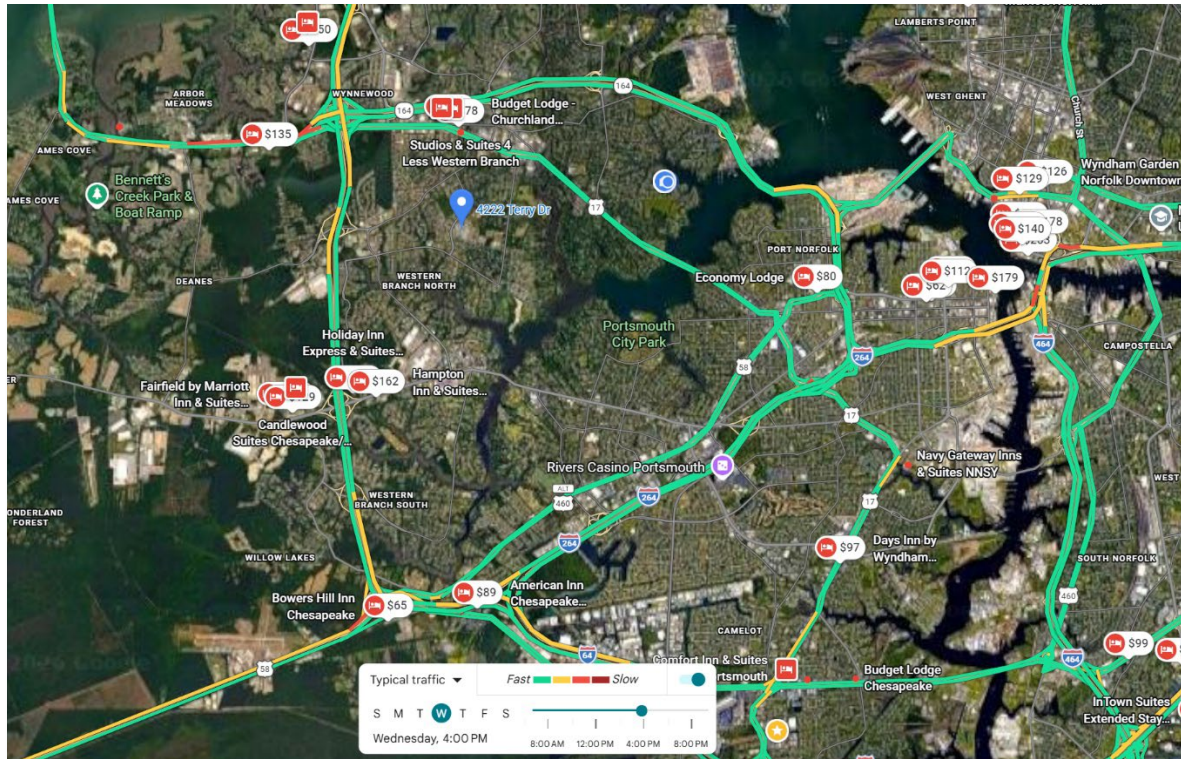
All Games will be held at the WBLL Complex. Practice fields will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please see WBLL.org for updates.

Lodging

There is ample lodging in Chesapeake and the surrounding areas. Please pay careful attention to the highlighted traffic on the map below. Hampton Roads has many waterways and uses both tunnels and bridges to traverse. These can add hours to your travel time if you become ensnared, even if only a few miles from the complex.



The following hotels are within an easy drive of the softball complex. Teams are responsible for contacting the hotels directly and making reservations. Teams are encouraged to make reservations as soon as they learn they will be representing their District at the State Tournament. Lodging expenses are the responsibility of the individual teams and fans. Other lodging options are available; however, they pose a traffic risk, with substantially longer travel times than the GPS estimate. Games will not be delayed due to traffic issues and may result in your team's forfeit.

Umpire Information

Approved Little League Volunteer Umpires will be used in all games. The Virginia District 6 Umpire Association and Western Branch Little League will provide a hospitality room for the umpires at the complex. Umpires are requested to contact the Virginia District 6 DA, Jean Albertson; the Virginia District 6 Umpire-in-Chief, Garrett Shelton; or the Assistant Tournament Director, Rowdy Whittington, using the contact information above.

Team Registration

All teams must register with the Tournament Officials at the WBLL complex between 1:00 and 4:00 pm on Thursday, July 9, 2026. Please get in touch with Virginia District 6 DA, Jean Albertson, if you are unable to register during this time.

Please be prepared to present the following items:

- Your team's up-to-date tournament eligibility affidavit signed and approved by your League President and District Administrator. The affidavits will be reviewed, approved, and returned by the Tournament Director before your team's first game. All managers and coaches must have proof of current (NFHS) Concussion Training Certification in the Notebook, along with the Diamond Leader Certificate.
- Two (2) copies of the medical release form for each player on your roster. One will be with the player verification form in the notebook, and the other should be retained by the team manager throughout the tournament in case of a medical emergency.
- Each team is responsible for making lodging arrangements. Participating leagues/teams are responsible for making hotel reservations and for any damage that occurs to rooms or other hotel property. If damage occurs to a room during the team's stay, the league/team/individual party is responsible for making restitution with the hotel.
- Team roster form (included in this packet) with names of all players and **official** coaching staff (Manager and up to two (2) coaches) as they would like to be announced. Please include player jersey numbers and double-check the spelling of all players' names.
- Your District Championship Banner.
- A welcome packet/goody bag will be provided for each player.

Note: Each team MUST have their approved tournament eligibility affidavit to participate in the tournament. Please take the time to review it before traveling to the tournament site and ensure all necessary documentation is included. This includes Diamond Leader Training and Concussion Awareness Training Certification from the NFHS for all Managers and Coaches. **Your team will not be permitted to register, practice or participate in the tournament without a valid, signed, and approved affidavit. No Exceptions.**

Opening Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will be held at the WBL complex on A-field. In the event of inclement weather, the opening ceremony will still be held at the complex, as there is ample space and dry seating. The Opening Ceremony is scheduled to begin promptly at 5:30 pm with team introductions. Team Managers are requested to have their teams in jerseys or appropriate T-shirts, shorts or jeans/slacks, and sneakers lined up and ready to be introduced by 5:15 pm. Additional details will be provided at check-in. Team uniforms are not required or expected. Please ensure you have your District Championship Banner to display as your team is introduced. Team pictures may be taken. The teams will line up and parade onto the field, and line up around the infield. The concession stand will be open with food and beverages for purchase.

Following the Opening Ceremony, all tournament participants are encouraged to enjoy the facility and participate in traditional Pin Trading with fellow competitors.

Pre-Tournament Meeting

A mandatory meeting for all managers, coaches, tournament officials, and umpires will be held at **7:00 pm** in the designated area/room following the opening ceremony. It is expected that this time will be used for participants to meet other teams and players and exchange commemorative pins.

We will review the tournament rules as well as the expectations and logistics of play: warm-up schedule, pre-game announcements, substitution process, etc.

All 2026 Little League Softball Tournament rules will be enforced and adhered to **without** exception. Please ensure that all equipment brought to the tournament site complies with Little League regulations and specifications. **Any equipment removed from the tournament will not be returned to its respective team until after its last game.** Neither the Tournament Director nor the Umpires in Chief has the authority to waive any rule without the express permission and approval of the Tournament Committee in Williamsport. All managers, coaches, players, and fans are encouraged to review the Tournament playing rules and Little League safety rules before they arrive to help prevent any surprises or misunderstandings. All managers and coaches are reminded to ensure they have completed NFHS Concussion Awareness Training within the last year, and the certificate is included in the Affidavit Notebook.



Tournament Playing and Practice Fields

All Tournament Games will be held at the Western Branch Little League complex:

All games will be played on the Western Branch Little League fields. The Concession Stand will be open, and there is ample parking. Bleacher seating is available, and lawn chairs are welcome. Playing fields are multi-purpose and feature skinned infields and grass outfields.

Practice fields will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Batting cages are available at the tournament site. Team Managers may reserve a practice field/batting cage when registering teams. No smoking or tobacco use is permitted at or near the playing fields, which includes vaping and chewing. No alcohol or illicit drugs shall be brought to the tournament site. Pets are not allowed at the field. The tournament site is located on Public School Property owned and operated by Chesapeake Public Schools, and all state and federal laws governing public schools are enforced.

Admission and Parking Fees

There will be no admission or parking fees during the Little League Softball Tournament. However, we do “pass the hat” during each game and ask tournament spectators and fans to donate what they can, in cash, to help defray tournament expenses. Thank you.

Spectator Policies and Procedures

Bleacher seating is available, and lawn chairs are welcome.

No noise makers of any kind may be used during tournament games; this includes cowbells, whistles, boat horns, etc. Special announcements or “walk-up” songs by fans are not permitted.

Individuals wishing to record or live stream games for personal use are not permitted to affix any equipment to the playing facility, including but not limited to fencing, dugouts, stanchions, or light poles. If fans wish to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open internet.

No smoking or tobacco use is permitted at the field or on school grounds, which includes vaping and chewing. No alcohol or illicit drugs shall be brought to the tournament site. Pets are not allowed at the field at any time.

Tournament Game Procedures and Guidelines

The tournament Format will be determined on the registration date, depending on the number of participating teams. The pools and/or first round matchups were drawn randomly at the Virginia State Little League Association Meeting in May 2026. All games shall be conducted in accordance with the 2026 Little League Softball® Tournament Rules and Guidelines.

Teams should plan to arrive at the field at least 75 minutes before game time and report immediately to the Tournament Director. Team managers will present the team's affidavit (only) with the pitching record to the Tournament Director. If not already done, a coin toss will decide the home and visiting teams. The team that has traveled the farthest will call the toss. The winner will choose whether to be the home or visitor. The Home team will occupy the first-base dugout on A-field and the third-base dugout on B-field. The visiting team will occupy the opposing dugout. No exceptions.

Teams will have 10 minutes of infield practice before each game (as time permits). A **rostered** coach or manager must be present before any player can take batting practice, infield practice, or occupy the dugout. Batting helmets must be worn when conducting batting practice. Non-rostered adults or children may **not** enter the dugout, the batting cage, **or** the playing field at any time before or during games. During the games and when warming up pitchers or conducting infield practice, catchers must wear an approved catcher's mask with a dangling throat protector.

When time allows, each team will be announced 10 minutes before every game, with the visiting team announced first. The National Anthem or the Little League Pledge will follow announcements. The plate conference with managers, umpires, and the Tournament Director will follow. Coaches and players shall remain in the dugout until the plate conference is concluded and the UIC instructs the defensive team to take the field. Base coaches may take their positions when directed by the UIC after the "throw down" to second base.

Every substitution, position change, etc., **must** be made from inside the field by the manager to the official scorer while accompanied by the umpire-in-chief. Once a change is announced, it is official. The manager is **always** 100% responsible for ensuring the change is proper and legal. The manager is also responsible for ensuring that mandatory play is met by all rostered players present at the game site.

After the game is over, be sure all information is properly recorded in your affidavit and acknowledged by the manager, official scorer, and the Tournament Director. Once you leave the field, the affidavits may not be changed.

Concession and Vendor Information

Each team is expected to provide food and beverages for their players, managers, and coaches throughout the tournament. Coolers may be brought to the tournament site, but grilling or open fires are not permitted at any time at the park. Food concessions will be available throughout the tournament, and the Concession Stand accepts cash and/or debit/credit cards. Internet Information

Game results will be reported, and tournament brackets will be updated and posted on the tournament site and on the Western Branch Little League website (WBLL.org). The host has no plans to stream games via Game Changer, Facebook, or other online platforms. If fans wish to stream a game, it must be viewed through a personal social media account for private use only and may not be on the open internet. If individuals wish to record or stream the game, the device may not be attached to any part of the field, including fences, backstop, dugout, light poles, etc. The recording device must be free-standing (or held) and may not be in the vicinity of the Press Box/Scorer's Table.

Team Equipment

Each team must provide its own equipment. District 6 and WBLL will aid in the event of an emergency. Please inspect your equipment before traveling. In accordance with Little League Softball® rules, **the team manager is responsible for ensuring that players are properly equipped and that all equipment meets Little League® standards, rules, and regulations. Tournament officials will not inspect equipment before the first game or any other game.** Managers are encouraged to inspect all equipment before reporting to the tournament site to ensure it is authorized and safe. Some items to look for include, but are not limited to:

- Helmets must be NOCSAE-approved and cannot be modified.
 - Altering a helmet in any way (drilling holes, removing padding, etc.) may cause a manufacturer to void the NOCSAE certification of that helmet, making it illegal (and unsafe) for use in Little League play. If you have altered your helmet or intend to do so, please contact the helmet manufacturer to determine whether altering it will void the NOCSAE certification.
 - Little League International issued a letter to all youth batting helmet manufacturers for clarification on whether adding C-flaps to their helmets voids their NOCSAE certification. Manufacturer responses are posted on Little League International's website, www.LittleLeague.org/HelmetAdditions, where you can find more information about helmet attachments as it becomes available.
 - Tournament officials will not be checking helmets to ensure they are safe and have not been altered. It is the team manager's responsibility to ensure all equipment is safe and that the manufacturer's warranty has not been voided.
- Catcher's masks must be NOCSAE-approved and must have a dangling throat protector. This includes hockey-style masks. If the throat protector does not dangle when the mask is turned to face the ground, it is not a dangling throat protector.
- Bats must be softball bats adhering to Little League rules and regulations: www.littleleague.org/help-center/does-my-bat-meet-the-softball-bat-standards/

Equipment that is damaged or not permitted will be removed from the dugout and will be held by the District 6 Staff until your team departs from the Tournament. Please leave non-Little League conforming equipment at home.

Local Entertainment and Restaurants

Hampton Roads and the surrounding area proudly share a distinctive heritage that visitors can experience through our significant sites, wayside exhibits, battlefields, and museums. Whether you're looking to explore Civil War battlefields, immerse yourself in exciting aviation history, or experience the vivid stories of the area's rich culture, this is the place to find it.

Chesapeake, Suffolk, and Portsmouth all have many local eateries and nationwide chains a short distance from the tournament complex. Keep in mind the traffic map included previously in this packet when planning meals and entertainment.

There are several parks with shelters and grilling available a short distance from the tournament fields. Go-karting, laser tag, bowling, movies, minor league baseball, beaches, and more are a short distance away.

Mementos

Each rostered player and coach will receive a commemorative pin. Teams are encouraged to bring Little League pins from their home District or League for trading. Custom 2026 Virginia State Little League Softball Junior Tournament Tee shirts, pins, and other items will be available for purchase at the tournament site.

Pictures

A local professional photographer will be on-site to take official team photos and action photos during the games, and the photos will be available for purchase. **No** unofficial team representatives will be allowed in the dugouts or on the fields during games. Photography or filming is allowed only through/over the fence. Teams will be able to schedule team pictures during registration.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship is often associated with taking a loss gracefully, but winning gracefully is just as important. The exposure of children to negative behavior from adults creates a challenge for coaches in emphasizing the difference between being passionate about a sport and exhibiting extreme negativity or hurtfulness. Please remind your team's parents and fans of the Parent Code of Conduct and how important it is for adults to set a good example for the ball players.

While the Little League® International Tournament focuses on winning to advance, it is also important to recognize that all teams earned the privilege of representing their league and District in the State Tournament and to enjoy the experience. **Please emphasize the importance of having fun and playing the game with respect, honor, and skill, regardless of the outcome.**

Medical Facilities

If any medical emergency should arise, please call 911. Please report any incident involving a player or coach to Jean Albertson, Rowdy Whittington, or Garrett Shelton as soon as possible. Players receiving medical attention for a softball-related injury **must** have written approval from a doctor to return to play. There are **no** exceptions.
